

Steps to earn college credit at SRJC through TeenNat

TeenNat participants can be eligible to receive **1 unit of credit through the SRJC course CI 51 (Community Engagement)** by following the instructions outlined below.

*Note: complete steps 1 and 2 *before summer vacation*. Connect with your High School Counselor as soon as possible for assistance with this process.

1. Apply to SRJC for Summer 2023 semester
 - a. complete CCCApply as a high school student:

2. Complete High School Dual Enrollment form
 - a. Select your HS from the list to begin the form:

 - b. Your parent/guardian is emailed for signature (this email is automatically sent)
 - c. Your High School principal/counselor is emailed for signature (this email is automatically sent)
 - d. You receive email confirmation from SRJC that your Dual Enrollment is complete!
3. Attend TeenNat orientation
 - a. Receive Add Code from Laurie Bacci - required to register for CI 51 ([Community Engagement](#))
 - b. Log into your SRJC Portal with your student ID: www.santarosa.edu/portal
 - c. Register for CI 51 using Add Code
 - d. Pay SRJC mandatory state fees (~\$20-30)
4. Actively participate in TeenNat program & CI 51 course
 - a. Develop 3 Learning Goals related to TeenNat (with assistance from TeenNat staff)
 - b. Complete your Timesheet and request signatures from TeenNat staff (at end of program)
 - c. Communicate with Laurie Bacci to fulfill remaining CI 51 course requirements
